Dear Parents

The children are really enjoying our new topic this term – ‘Farm to Fork’ and have been enthusiastic during lessons. They have been asking many interesting and intriguing questions and have been supporting their learning with additional work at home.

The infants have been focusing on ‘How do animals give us food?’ this week in literacy and have been reading and writing information texts. They have also been learning about why the Quran is important to Muslims in RE and practising programming during computing lessons.



The juniors have been writing explanations about the manufacturing of our food including how ice cream is made and how sausages are produced. They have been discovering which parts of the world our food comes from and where certain food types are grown and reared. In science they have started to learn about the human circulatory system.

A curriculum newsletter has been sent out today with more detail about the children’s learning for this term.

Thursday 23rd January at SMCC

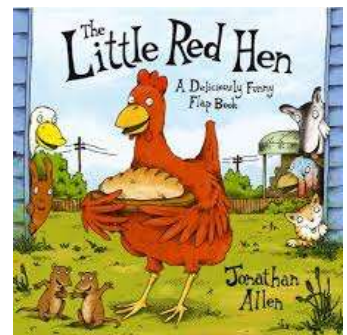
