Yellow = well-being


Learning Support

Overview: provision of TA time to deliver intervention programmes to support small groups and individual children. Use of TAs to provide 'top up' sessions.

Cost £12,000

Overview: License, training and books purchase

Cost £ 600

Increased confidence (discussion)
Increased attainment in Reading, Writing (Assessment Data) and improved engagement with books and school library. Encourage more parental support.

Ability to respond quickly to pupils needs and needs within the family and provide a holistic solution for home and school.


Breakfast/Afterschool Care

Overview: Free places to enable parents to attend meetings and school functions

Pastoral Support Worker

Overview: Differentiated tutorial sessions with individuals. Emotional well-being support.

Cost: £2000

Overview: School Uniform provided for those in most need.

Subsidised Educational Trips

Overview: School trips and residential subsidised by at least 50% to ensure access for all pupils.

Aim/Outcomes:


Raise aspiration, motivation and engagement. Secure equal opportunity. Raise aspirations.

Overview: Monies available to support children in developing their social engagement in a practical context.

Cost: £1200

Subsidised Transport to School Events

Overview: Transport to school events, such as swimming and rock climbing subsidised by at least 50% to ensure access for all pupils

Cost: £1500
