Our Summer term topic is 'Farm to Fork'.

We're excited to start work on our new topic, 'Farm to Fork', which teaches children about the features and characteristics of land use in agricultural regions across the world, including a detailed exploration of significant environmental areas.

We will be making the most of the expertise of our resident volunteer gardener, Simon, who has invited us to visit his allotment both at the start and end of term. This will allow us to observe the changes that take place over the most active growing period.

The children's exploration will also be enhanced by a trip to the Eden Project, where we will take part in a workshop called Sustainability Sussed which challenges the children to go on a journey and discover the sustainability stories behind the foods they eat each lunchtime. We will also have some time to explore the biomes and gardens.
