Reception: We will be introducing your children to Read Write Inc (RWI) and will start teaching them their Set 1 sounds with a focus on segmenting and blending to start reading and

This term our topic is all about ourselves and we will cover the following:

- Throwing.
- Striking.

We will also focus on our fine motor control through daily Funky Fingers activities and the playdough station.
